Subject Mammogram Diagnostic Services and Testing

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Overview

This bill requires health plans, medical assistance, and MinnesotaCare to cover additional diagnostic services or testing after a mammogram if a health care provider believes it is necessary.

Summary

Section Description

1 Mammogram; diagnostic services and testing.

Provides that if an enrollee requires additional diagnostic services or testing after a mammogram, a health plan must provide coverage for these services and testing with no-cost sharing, including co-pays, deductible, or coinsurance.

Effective date. This section is effective January 1, 2024.

2 Exceptions.

Prohibits the application of co-pays and deductibles for mammogram diagnostic services and testing for medical assistance enrollees.

Effective date. This section is effective January 1, 2024.

3 Cost-sharing.

Prohibits the application of co-pays and deductibles for mammogram diagnostic services and testing for MinnesotaCare enrollees.

Effective date. This section is effective January 1, 2024.
