

**Subject** Contributions During Legislative Session

## Summary

This bill prohibits lobbyists, political committees, and political funds from making contributions for the purpose of:

- 1) attending an event during a regular session of the legislature, when the event is held by either a principal campaign committee of a candidate for legislative or constitutional office, or by the political party organization within a house of the legislature; or
- 2) membership or access to a facility operated during a regular session of the legislature, when access is provided by the principal campaign committee of a candidate for legislative or constitutional office, or by the political party organization within a house of the legislature.

While the underlying law being amended by this bill generally prohibits contributions only during regular sessions of the legislature, the particular prohibitions added by this bill would apply regardless of the time when the contribution is made.
