Summary

Under current law, students enrolled in high school or an equivalent home school program, and who are least age 16, are permitted to be appointed as a trainee election judge in the county of the student's residence or an immediately neighboring county. As the law is written, trainee election judges must be current students.

This bill would permit students who are appointed as trainee election judges while they are enrolled in a high school or receiving home school instruction to continue to serve as trainee election judges after their graduation and until they reach the age of 18.
