Overview

This bill appropriates \$7,900,000 each fiscal year from the general fund to the commissioner of health for family planning grants. Under the family planning grants program, the commissioner distributes grants to clinics, local public health agencies, and nonprofit organizations to fund the provision of prepregnancy family planning services. These services include the provision of family planning counseling services; distribution of information about family planning; referrals to health care providers or local health agencies for examinations, medical treatment, and prescriptions; and distribution of family planning products. In fiscal year 2022, \$6,353,000 was appropriated for family planning grants, and 24 grant recipients received grants. Grants are awarded to recipients in each region of the state.

Appropriates \$7,900,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$7,900,000 in fiscal year 2025 from the general fund to the commissioner of health for family planning grants, distributed to local units of government and nonprofit organizations for the provision of prepregnancy family planning services.
