Summary

This bill adds the definition of “political affiliation” to Chapter 363A, the Minnesota Human Rights Act (MHRA), and defines it as association with or support for a political party or political candidate.

The bill adds the term “political affiliation” to the list of protected classes in the MHRA and prevents discrimination against a person because of their political affiliation in regard to employment, housing, public accommodations, public services, education, credit applications, and business and contracting.
