## Summary

Under current statute, the Board of Nursing may issue a nonrenewable temporary permit to practice nursing to an applicant for licensure by endorsement (without examination) who is currently licensed in another state, territory, or Canadian province. The temporary permit for such applicants is valid until the board acts on the application, but for no more than 60 days. This bill would extend the temporary permit for applicants for licensure by endorsement from 60 days to 90 days.
