| 1 | <b>Opiate antagonist.</b><br>Requires Minnesota State Colleges and Universities and requests the University of Minnesota to maintain a supply of nasal opiate antagonist at each campus residential building. Requires the commissioner of health to assist postsecondary institutions with training and planning regarding opiate antagonists. |
| 2 | <b>Administration of opiate antagonists for drug overdose.</b><br>Allows a nurse or other personnel employed by a postsecondary institution to be authorized by a physician to administer opiate antagonists.   |
