

Subject Earned Incentive Release Credits (Minnesota Rehabilitation and Reinvestment Act)

Summary

Establishes that earned incentive release credits under the Minnesota Rehabilitation and Reinvestment Act program can be revoked if the credit holder violates rules of the prison or otherwise commits a criminal act while incarcerated. Under current law, earned incentive release credits, once earned, are not revocable.

Authorizes the commissioner of corrections to deny an offender supervision abatement if doing so would present a risk to public safety.
