

Subject Modifying provisions related to the manufacture and sale of products containing cannabinoids derived from hemp

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Overview

This bill modifies provisions related to the manufacture and sale of products containing cannabinoids derived from hemp.

Summary

Section	Description
1	<p>Sale of cannabinoids derived from hemp.</p> <p>Establishes that products subject to the section of law governing temporary regulations for certain products that contain nonintoxicating cannabinoids derived from hemp cannot be intended to be consumed through application to nonintact skin, but can be consumed sublingually.</p>
2	<p>Building conditions.</p> <p>Requires lower-potency hemp edible manufacturers to comply with zoning requirements, fire codes, and building codes. Requires those manufacturers to maintain licensed premises in a clean and sanitary condition.</p>
3	<p>Contents of label; hemp-derived topical products.</p> <p>Eliminates the option to provide information on a product manufacturer, the laboratory used to test a product, and the cannabinoid profile of a product through the use of a matrix barcode (QR code).</p>
4	<p>Prohibitions.</p> <p>Establishes that products subject to the section of law establishing permanent regulations for certain products that contain nonintoxicating cannabinoids derived from hemp cannot be intended to be consumed through application to nonintact skin, but can be consumed sublingually.</p>



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
