Summary

This bill would add four state agencies to the Opioids, Substance Use, and Addiction Subcabinet. The new members would be the chief executive officer of Direct Care and Treatment, the director of the Office of Cannabis Management, and the commissioners of Commerce and Children, Youth, and Families.

The legislature established the Opioids, Substance Use, and Addiction Subcabinet by law in 2022 to, among other things, coordinate the efforts of various state agencies that have a role in preventing or addressing opioid and substance use disorders in Minnesota.
