Summary

Minnesota statutes, section 200.031, lists principles for determining a person's residence for purposes of voting. This bill specifies that for a person committed to a secure treatment facility under chapter 253D (the Minnesota Sex Offender Program) as having a sexual psychopathic personality or as a sexually dangerous person, the person's residence for voting purposes is the person's last known residential address prior to the issuance of the commitment order.
