Subject Preexisting condition limitations in Medicare supplement insurance

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Date March 21, 2025

### **Overview**

This bill removes the requirement that Medicare supplement insurance policies have an open enrollment period and allows for preexisting condition limitations.

#### 1 Policy requirements.

## 2 Suspension based on entitlement to medical assistance.

Allows for a preexisting condition waiting period.

#### 3 Limitations on denials, conditions, and pricing of coverage.

Allows a preexisting condition limitation to apply to Medicare supplement policies during the open enrollment period.

#### 4 Renewal or continuation provisions.

Requires a Medicare supplement policy that contains preexisting condition limitations to appear as a separate paragraph and be titled.

## 5 Guaranteed issue for eligible persons.

Removes the requirement that for certain eligible people the open enrollment period is a guaranteed issue period.

#### 6 **Prohibited policy provisions.**

Updates cross-reference.

#### 7 Questions.

Updates notice form to explain preexisting condition limitations and waiting periods.

## 8 Repealer.

Repeals Minnesota Statutes, section 62A.3099, subdivision 18b and section 62A.31, subdivision 1w; and Laws 2023, chapter 57, article 2, section 66.

## 9 **Effective date.**

This act is effective the day following final enactment.



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
