Overview

This bill requires a notice to be posted at a closed polling place, if the polling place is changed to another location.

Summary

Section Description

1 Notice to voters.

Requires that, if the location of a polling place is changed, the local election official must post a notice at the closed location, and if practical, must also post a notice in a location visible to voters who vote from their vehicle. The notice is required to be posted for each primary and general election until a presidential election or redistricting has occurred.

A sample notice to be used for this purpose must be prepared by the secretary of state.
