Summary

Makes the commissioner of commerce responsible for the functions, programs, personnel, powers, responsibilities, duties, and oversight of the Commerce Fraud Bureau.

The governor issued [Executive Order 25-01](#) on January 3, 2025, removing the Commerce Fraud Bureau from the oversight of the commissioner of commerce and transferring it, and the related personnel and funding as well as the Automobile Theft Prevention Program, to the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension.
