| 1 | <p><b>Definitions.</b></p> <p>Changes the definition of “custodian” from any person (other than the petitioner or respondent) who is under a legal obligation to care for a minor child or who is caring for a minor child to a person (other than the petitioner or respondent) who has physical or legal custody as the mother of a child, a person who has court ordered custody or parenting time, or who has physical or legal custody with the consent of a custodial parent.</p> |
