## Summary

This bill appropriates \$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2026 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to Age Well at Home to establish the Minnesota Age in Place Network, describes eligible uses of grant money, and allows Age Well at Home to use up to ten percent of the grant money for administrative expenses.

Age Well at Home serves homeowners of color and aging low-income homeowners by making home modifications to allow homeowners to remain in their homes.
