

Subject Eliminating the community justice reinvestment account and annual transfer

Overview

In 2016, the legislature made multiple changes to provisions in law related to controlled substance offenses. As part of that change, the legislature established the community justice reinvestment account. Money in the account was to be used for grants to support mental health and chemical dependency treatment programs and for other programming related to controlled substances offenders. In 2019, the legislature established a statutory transfer of \$461,000 each year from the general fund into the account.

This bill repeals the account and annual transfer.
