Subject Excise tax on plastic bottles**Authors** Franson**Analyst** Bob Eleff**Date** March 9, 2026**Summary**

House File 3322, amended by the H3322DE2 amendment, imposes an excise tax on distributors of plastic beverage bottles, the proceeds of which are to be used for grants to communities for water infrastructure projects.

The tax, a yet-to-be-determined amount, is imposed on the first person who sells such bottles to a retailer in Minnesota. Revenues from the tax are placed in an account and appropriated to the Public Facilities Authority, which may use them only for water infrastructure projects. The tax is effective beginning January 1, 2027, through 2031.
