

Subject Local Optional Revenue; Increase for Districts without a Referendum

Overview

Local optional revenue is a component of general education revenue. A school district's local optional revenue equals \$724 per pupil unit. Local optional revenue (LOR) is available to school districts only and is not available to charter schools.

Local optional revenue consists of two tiers. LOR first tier revenue is \$300 per pupil and is equalized at \$880,000 per pupil. The second tier of LOR, \$424 per pupil, is equalized at \$671,345.

H.F. 3371 proposes a third tier of LOR of up to \$100 per pupil unit for those districts without any referendum revenue authority approved by their voters. About one-quarter of Minnesota's school districts do not have a voter approved operating referendum. If all eligible school districts chose to exercise the new LOR authority, LOR revenue would increase by about \$13.2 million, of which \$2.3 million is state aid, and the remaining \$10.9 million is through the local property tax levy.
