

**Subject** Disability Waiver Rate System

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## Overview

This bill modifies billing limits placed on individualized home supports with training and individualized home supports with family training under the disability waiver rate system (DWRS).

DWRS is Minnesota's uniform, statewide methodology to determine reimbursement rates for home and community-based services provided under the four Medicaid (MA) disability waivers—the community alternative care (CAC) waiver, the community access for disability inclusion (CADI) waiver, the developmental disability (DD) waiver, and the brain injury (BI) waiver.

Individualized home supports is a service provided under the MA disability waivers that provides support and/or training in community participation; health, safety, and wellness; household management; and adaptive skills. There are three individualized home supports service options available—without training, with training, and with family training.
