This bill appropriates \$50,000,000 for a onetime aid to counties and Tribes for rental assistance.

| 1 | <p><b>Appropriation; emergency rental assistance aid.</b></p> <p>Appropriates \$50,000,000 from the general fund to the commissioner of revenue for the aid under this section, apportioning \$44,000,000 for counties and \$6,000,000 for Tribes. Requires distribution of the aid to counties and Tribes by the Department of Revenue within 15 days after enactment, using the distribution formulas used for local homeless prevention aid. Limits use of the aid to rental assistance for households that are Minnesota residents under 200 percent of the federal poverty level that are in a housing crisis—comparable to eligibility standards used for the family homeless prevention and assistance program. Requires expenditure of the aid within 180 days and a return of money unspent within that timeline. Allows counties and Tribes to contract with the same entities allowed to administer local homeless prevention aid.</p> |
