This bill prohibits employees of child care centers from consenting to a federal, state, or local official entering a child care center for the purpose of civil immigration enforcement without a warrant signed by a judicial officer authorizing the arrest of a particular individual. The employee must ask the official to provide valid identification and a written statement of purpose. If a federal, state, or local official engaged in civil immigration enforcement enters a child care center, an on-duty employee must immediately notify the child care center license holder or authorized agent.
