Summary

This bill prohibits public schools from consenting to federal, state, or local officials entering schools for purposes of immigration enforcement unless the official has a valid judicial warrant. A school employee must ask the official to provide valid identification and immediately notify the superintendent and general counsel, and may grant entry to only the areas identified in the warrant.

The bill includes a severability section that states that if the act is found unconstitutional as to any person, entity, or circumstance, the remaining provisions of the act remain valid.
