## Summary

This bill appropriates an unspecified amount in fiscal year 2027 to the commissioner of public safety for the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, in consultation with the Minnesota School Safety Center, to issue anonymous threat reporting system grants to school districts, charter schools, cooperative units, or Tribal contract schools. Grant funds may be used for expenses associated with the development, purchase, implementation, operation, and maintenance of an anonymous threat reporting system.

A recipient must obtain a 50 percent match from nonstate funds, and document how the grant will be used, including identifying how staff will respond to threats received through the system.
