Overview

This bill establishes a special plate for fraternities and sororities that are members of the National Pan-Hellenic Council. It provides for plate requirements, eligibility, donations, design, and transfer. Effective January 1, 2027.

Summary

Section Description

1 **[Adds § 168.1261] Panhellenic plates.**

Establishes a Panhellenic special license plate.

Subd. 1. Issuance of plates. Sets requirements for issuance of the plate, which includes specifying eligible types of vehicles and requiring a \$40 annual donation.

Subd. 2. Organization eligibility. Authorizes a fraternity or sorority to request a plate design specific to that organization if it is a member of the National Pan-Hellenic Council and has an affiliated charitable foundation.

Subd. 3. Design. Sets requirements on plate design for each requesting organization.

Subd. 4. Plates transfer. Provides for plate transfer between qualified vehicles.

Subd. 5. Exemption. Exempts the special plate from statutory mandates on special plate application, a survey on intended plate purchases, and a marketing strategy.

Subd. 6. Contributions; account; appropriation. Creates an account for special plate donations. Appropriates the funds for administrative costs and distribution to charitable foundations.
