

Subject Corrections – Supervision Abatement Status

Summary

The Minnesota Rehabilitation and Reinvestment Act of 2023 created a pathway for offenders under the supervision of the commissioner of corrections to reduce their incarceration and supervision periods through good behavior. This bill would prohibit the commissioner from placing an offender on supervision abatement status until the offender pays all court-ordered restitution. (Supervision abatement status means the end of active correctional supervision of a supervised person.)
