

Subject Access to public voter registration information list

Summary

This bill permits the national chair of a major political party to request a copy of the public voter registration information list. Under current law, this list may only be provided to a registered Minnesota voter.

The public information list is maintained locally by a county auditor, and contains the name, address, year of birth, and voting history for each registered voter in the county, with certain exceptions. It may also include a voter's telephone number, and information on voting districts. Use of the list is limited to elections, political activities, and law enforcement.
