

Subject Hemp product laboratory testing

Summary

This bill extends the expired laboratory testing requirements that allow for the testing of lower-potency hemp edibles and hemp-derived consumer products that do not contain intoxicating cannabinoids at any accredited laboratory. Under current law, cannabis and hemp products must be tested at a Minnesota-licensed cannabis testing facility. This bill is effective the day following final enactment and allows for this testing until May 31, 2027.
