

Subject Electronic Visit Verification

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Overview

This bill expands the list of services required to use electronic visit verification (EVV).

The federal 21st Century Cures Act (Pub. Law 114-255) requires EVV for certain home care providers to document that people are receiving the services being billed to Medicaid. The EVV system verifies the type of service performed, who received the service, the date of the service, the location of the service, who provided the service, and when the service begins and ends. Providers have the option of using either the state-provided EVV system or an alternative system of their choosing that meets state requirements.

Minnesota began implementing EVV in 2022.
