| 1 | <p>Facial recognition technology.</p> <p>Creates a new section of statute prohibiting government entities from using facial recognition technology.</p> <p>Subd. 1. Definitions. Defines key terms.</p> <p>Subd. 2. Ban on government use of face surveillance. Prohibits a government entity—on its own or through an arrangement with a private entity—from using a facial surveillance system or using information obtained from such a system.</p> <p>Subd. 3. Enforcement. Prohibits information obtained from a facial surveillance system from being used in any court or other government proceedings. Requires a government entity to delete any data it obtains in violation of this section. Authorizes private lawsuits for damages or other equitable relief for violations of this section.</p> |
