Summary

This bill revives a section of law governing voting procedures during precinct caucuses that was repealed in 2023. The subdivisions revived under Minnesota Statutes § [202A.16](#) (2022) include three requirements to participate in a precinct caucus:

- 1) A voter must be eligible to vote at the next state general election to be able to vote or be elected a delegate or officer at the precinct caucus.
- 2) A voter must have voted or affiliated with the party at the last state general election or intend to vote or affiliate with the party at the next state general election to be able to vote at the precinct caucus.
- 3) The whole caucus must determine the right of a person to participate in the caucus if a person's right to participate is challenged.

Effective the day following final enactment.
