

**Subject** Deceased voter removal from statewide voter registration system

## Summary

This bill requires each county auditor to remove a voter from the statewide voter registration system after changing the voter's status to "deceased" and requires all voters with "deceased" status to be removed from the registration system by June 1, 2027.

Current law requires each county auditor to change a voter's registration status in the statewide voter registration system to "deceased" upon receiving notice that a registered voter has died. A voter's registration status as "deceased" is a separate statutory classification from a voter's status as "inactive."

Effective upon final enactment.
