## Overview

This bill repeals a variety of programs that are no longer funded and makes conforming changes.

## Summary

1	<p><b>Priorities.</b></p> <p>Makes a conforming change to the repeal of the Minnesota green enterprise assistance program. Removes priority for projects that advance or promote the green economy from the redevelopment grant program.</p>
2	<p><b>Eligible projects.</b></p> <p>Makes a conforming change to the repeal of the Minnesota green enterprise assistance program. Removes priority for projects that advance or promote the green economy from the Minnesota investment fund program.</p>
3	<p><b>Other uses of revolving fund.</b></p> <p>Makes a conforming change to the repeal of the tourism loan program. Removes the tourism loan program as an eligible use of the clean water revolving fund.</p>
4	<p><b>Payments.</b></p> <p>Makes a conforming change to the repeal of the tourism loan program. Removes a mention of the tourism loan program from payment requirements for the clean water revolving fund.</p>
5	<p><b>Repealer.</b></p> <p>Repeals the following programs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Minnesota green enterprise assistance, which was last funded in 2009;</li><li>▪ tourism loan program, which was last funded in 2001 and had its special revenue account repealed in 2003;</li></ul>

- Minnesota science and technology economic development project, which became a different program in 2010 (which was itself repealed in 2013); and
- economic response team, which has never been funded in 16 years of existence and has been restructured.

Also repeals certain operation procedures for youth employment.
