

Subject Making changes related to data about crimes

Overview

This bill contains provisions related to data collection, sharing information regarding orders for protection against financial exploitation of a vulnerable adult, and terminology used in relation to the undercover buy fund and witness and victim protection fund.

Summary

Section	Description
1	Crime data collection. Specifies that data the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension is required to collect must be provided to the bureau in the form prescribed by the superintendent.
2	Undercover buy fund; witness and victim protection. Changes references to “grants” in the undercover buy fund and witness and victim protection fund to “reimbursements.”
3	Orders for protection; no contact orders; harassment restraining orders. Requires that the data communications network maintained by the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension include orders for protection issued under section 609.2334 (order for protection against financial exploitation of a vulnerable adult).
4	Copy to law enforcement agency; lead investigative agency. Requires the court administrator to make orders for protection against financial exploitation of a vulnerable adult available to law enforcement officers.
5	Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to identify eligible persons and grant expungement relief. Authorizes the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to determine that a record sealed pursuant to the automatic expungement law was sealed in error and should be unsealed.

Section	Description
6	Repealer. Repeals section 299C.12 which requires peace officers to keep a permanent written record of certain information and share that with the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension.
