## Summary

This bill would extend the expiration date for the Legislative Commission on Cybersecurity from December 31, 2028, to December 31, 2035.

**Background:** The legislature established the Legislative Commission on Cybersecurity in 2021 to oversee the state's cybersecurity measures and to review state agency cybersecurity policies and practices. The commission consists of eight legislators, four from the Senate and four from the House of Representatives, with equal membership from the majority and minority caucuses in each house. The commission may develop recommendations and draft legislation to protect the state from cybersecurity threats and to support and strengthen the state's cybersecurity infrastructure.
