Overview

This bill makes policy and technical changes to the statute governing metropolitan area water supply planning activities and related advisory committees.

Summary

Section Description

- 1 **§ 473.1565 Metropolitan area water supply planning activities; advisory committees.**
- Subd. 1. Planning activities.** Adds clarifying language to a list of technical water supply information required to be developed and maintained by the Metropolitan Council.
- Subd. 2. Policy advisory committee.** Makes changes to the Metropolitan Area Water Supply Policy Advisory Committee. Changes county official appointment to be by county administrator or county manager. Adds a Tribal representative to be appointed by the Minnesota Indian Affairs Council. Adds language clarifying the allowable length of service for a committee member. Requires resignation of an elected public official that loses their qualification to serve on the committee.
- Subd. 2a. Technical advisory committee.** Authorizes one Tribal representative member of the Metropolitan Area Water Supply Technical Advisory Committee. Makes technical formatting changes.
- Subd. 3. Reports to legislature.** Deletes a reference to the Legislative Water Commission, which was replaced by the LCC Subcommittee on Minnesota Water Policy. The statute establishing the commission expired July 1, 2019

Effective the day following final enactment.
