Overview

This bill adds Tribal governments and Tribal development entities as development authorities for the purposes of the Metropolitan Council's Livable Communities grant programs and the community tree-planting grant program.

All sections are effective the day following final enactment and apply in the counties of Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott, and Washington.
