

**Subject** Age for driver education

## Summary

This bill extends the ages when a driver's license applicant must complete driver education, to include a person who is age 18, 19, or 20.

Under current law, there are not driver education requirements for applicants age 18 or older. Completion of the classroom phase of driver education (or part of classroom work when there is concurrent behind-the-wheel instruction) is required for a minor to obtain an instruction permit. Completion of driver education is required for a provisional license.
