

Subject Community Corrections Act

Overview

This bill modifies the process by which a county elects to become a Community Corrections Act (CCA) jurisdiction, clarifies the duties of the state and counties regarding payment of benefits entitled to supervision agents, and appropriates funds to reimburse counties for costs related to transitioning to CCA jurisdictions.

Subd. 1. County and Tribal Nation authority. Authorizes a county seeking to become a CCA jurisdiction to submit a resolution adopted by the county board declaring the county's intent to become a CCA jurisdiction.

Subd. 2. Providing for displaced employees. Seeks to preserve an employee's job classification and rate of pay when they transfer between state and local employment in the state's corrections supervision system. Clarifies the obligations of the state and counties when employees switch between state and county employment under the CCA.

2	Appropriation; report.

Appropriates an unspecified amount in fiscal year 2027 to the commissioner of corrections for benefit and fringe benefit payouts for employee transitions between entities. Requires the commissioner of corrections to file a report with the legislature on how the appropriation was distributed.
