

**Subject** Fees waived for residential improvement for veteran with a disability

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## Overview

This bill prohibits the imposition of certain municipal fees associated with a residential improvement that is required to accommodate the disability of a veteran who resides on the property.

## Summary

Section Description

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- 1 **[326B.161] Fees waived for residential improvement for veteran with a disability.**
- Subd. 1. Definitions.** Defines the following terms for the purposes of the section: “disability,” “municipality,” “residential improvement,” and “veteran.”
- Subd. 2. Municipal fees waived; veterans with a disability.** Prohibits a municipality from charging certain municipal fees for a residential improvement that is required to accommodate the disability of a veteran who resides on the property.
- Subd. 3. Nonpayment of fee.** Prohibits a municipality from refusing to issue a license, building permit, or other approval or conduct an inspection or other necessary activity for a residential improvement required to accommodate the disability of a veteran due to the nonpayment of an associated fee.
- Subd. 4. Application; proof of veteran status required.** Clarifies that requirements for completion and submission of an application, form, or other document for an approval, inspection, or other necessary activity for a residential improvement still apply. Requires a veteran to provide proof of veteran status and to attest that a residential remodel or renovation is required to accommodate the veteran’s disability.

Effective the day following final enactment.



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
