## Summary

This bill would prohibit the assignment of legislative email addresses, telephone numbers, and offices to anyone who is not a member, officer, or employee of the senate or the house of representatives.

The legislative telephone number assigned to a senator or representative would be for their exclusive use and, if authorized by the member, by an employee assigned to the member. Members, officers, and employees would be prohibited from allowing a contractor or other person to office in legislative spaces without prior written notification to the leaders of each caucus.

H.F. 4172 would direct the senate and the house of representatives to adopt rules to implement this section, which must include remedies for violations. These remedies would be exclusive and no court or administrative agency would have authority to act upon a violation or otherwise interpret this section.
