## Overview

This bill prohibits health plan companies from placing quantity limitations on home care nursing services and provides a definition health plan companies must adopt for home care nursing services.

(c) Prohibits a health plan from imposing quantity limitations for coverage under this section.

(d) Requires health plans to adopt the definition of “home care nursing services” described in paragraph (e).

(e) Defines “home care nursing services” to mean ongoing, individual, and continuous nursing services that are ordered by a medical provider acting within the scope of their practice, is medically necessary, and required for a duration or frequency that cannot be met by intermittent or episodic care.

**Effective date.** Paragraph (c) is effective January 1, 2026, and applies to policies issued, offered, or renewed and cause of action accruing on or after that date. Paragraphs (d) and (e) are effective August 1, 2026.
