

Subject Government Data Practices: Personnel Data

Summary

This bill expands the protection of specified personnel data on employees of secure treatment programs or similar treatment programs, including the Minnesota Sex Offender Program. It provides that certain otherwise publicly available data on those employees must not be disclosed to facility patients or clients or to others who may use the information to harass, intimidate, or assault the employees. The bill also allows a government entity to require a data requestor to identify themselves when they are seeking data about an employee that may be protected under this subdivision.
