Overview

This bill would require annual reporting to the legislature regarding the implementation status of recommendations issued to agencies and other entities by the Office of the Legislative Auditor (OLA) in financial audits, program evaluations, and special reviews. The reports would address all OLA recommendations issued in the last five years.

Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB) would submit a status report to OLA each September, with particular emphasis given to any recommendations that have not been implemented. OLA would submit its report to legislative committees each February.

Summary

Section Description

1 Implementation of audit recommendations.

Requires OLA, as resources permit, to submit an annual report to the leaders of each legislative committee with jurisdiction over an entity subject to OLA oversight. Requires OLA to report, as resources, permit, to the legislative committees to which OLA did or did not present the annual report required under this bill.

2 Monitoring Office of the Legislative Auditor audits.

Requires MMB to submit an annual report to OLA detailing the implementation status of all OLA recommendations issued in the previous five years, itemizing those that have not been implemented and providing the basis for that decision.

3 Appropriations.

Appropriates money to OLA and MMB for purposes of the duties established in this bill.
