Summary

This bill modifies existing protections for employees who take certain protected actions, such as reporting actual or suspected criminal activity (i.e., "whistleblowing"). H.F. 23 would prohibit the state or a local unit of government from firing or taking other adverse action against an employee who, in good faith, reports gross mismanagement or a gross waste of funds to the employer, a governmental body, law enforcement, the Office of the Legislative Auditor, a member of the legislature, or a constitutional officer.
