

## Aid Losses to First Class Cities under HF 984 Property Tax Division Report With Author's Amendment

**Basic provision:** Beginning with aids payable in 2016, limits aid payments to first class cities to a per capita amount equal to 112.5% of the average per capita aid payment to all other cities for that year. The average per capita LGA payment to all cities, except first class cities, is \$96.14 for aids payable in 2016. 112.5% of that is \$108.16 per capita

There are only four first class cities in the state. The table below shows the aid reductions for aids payable in 2015 and 2016 to those cities.

**Additional cut for 2016 only:** The city of Minneapolis receives an additional LGA for aids payable in 2016 only equal to \$6.364 million. This cut is offset by the city being allowed to keep \$6.364 million of its city sales tax revenues in FY 2016 and 2017 that would otherwise go the sports facility authority. The city may deposit this additional sales tax revenue in its general fund and use for any governmental purpose.
