The county board is responsible for redistricting county commissioner districts, and any precincts located within unorganized territory within the county. The county auditor assists in coordinating redistricting processes with cities, townships, school districts, and the secretary of state.

Standards for creating county commissioner districts

(Minn. Stat § 375.025)

- County must contain as many districts as there are members of the board of commissioners.
- District boundaries must be creating using precinct lines.
- Districts must be composed of contiguous territory.
- Districts must be as regular and compact in form as practicable.
- Districts must be as nearly equal in population as possible; population of any one district may not vary by more than 10 percent from the average population size of all districts, unless it would cause a precinct to be split.
- A majority of the least populous districts contain may not contain less than a majority of the population of the county.

Other statutory provisions

- Counties may levy a special redistricting tax to cover expenses, with certain restrictions. (Minn. Stat. § 204B.135, subd. 5)
- A court may appoint a redistricting commission if the county board has not been sufficiently diligent in performing its duties to redistrict. (Minn. Stat. § 375.025, subd. 2)
