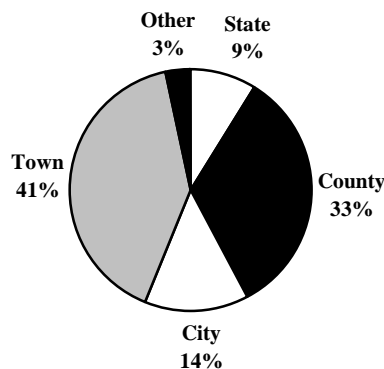


Minnesota Highway Mileage
