The essay, limited to 500 words, should answer the question "Why do you wish to participate in the 2023 High School Page Program?" Students should use this essay to describe their interest in the program and reasons for applying.

In addition to the written essay, the application should include **one** letter of recommendation from a teacher or academic advisor.

## **GUIDELINES AND PROVISIONS**

Please carefully review the following information.

- Program participants are expected to participate in all scheduled events and activities; accommodations in the schedule will not be made for extracurricular activities or other prior commitments.
- Participants are not permitted to leave any of the program's activities without the explicit authorization of the program coordinator.
- Participants are under direct supervision during sponsored program activities and events. Students staying at the hotel will be chaperoned during the evening hours and overnight.
- Program participants are expected to adhere to a professional dress code. Students that do not follow the dress code will not be allowed to participate in program activities.
- Program participants are responsible for all personal costs (i.e. travel) associated with their participation in the program. Students will receive a small stipend designated to cover a portion of their meals. Lodging costs will be covered for those who choose to stay at the program sponsored hotel.
- If the Legislature adjourns prior to the completion of the program, the remainder of the High School Page Program will be cancelled and affected students will be notified accordingly.
